#### **CHILI RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Spaces of 20'x20' maximum will be assigned on a first received basis, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 2. There will be limited access! Only one (1) vehicle at a time, per space, may enter the cook—off area. Your vehicle MUST be inside your 20'x20' area. NO EXCEPTIONS! No vehicle will be allowed in after 11 AM on Saturday. If your vehicle DOES NOT fit in your space, it is expected to be parked in the specified parking area.
- 3. The meat from which entries are to be taken will not be allowed in pots before meat is inspected. It must be inspected by the Committee from 8 am to noon on Saturday, October 21, 2023. SEASONED OR MARINATED MEAT IS NOT ALLOWED! CHILI must consist of at least 3 lbs. (three) of meat only. No beans or rice in the chili.
- 4. Beans may be only <u>PINTO BEANS</u>. <u>Beans must not be cooked</u> <u>prior to inspection but can be soaked</u>. Anything larger than a Pinto Bean turned in will be disqualified. **NO CANNED BEANS!**
- 5. Chef Choice main ingredient has to have SPAM in it.
- 6. Containers/Cups will be provided for all entries.
- 7. Contestants may not share cooking equipment. Contestants may share spaces. Each team must have a chief cook. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. Propane or butane cookers must be used for cooking Chili. OPEN FLAMES OF ANY KIND ARE NOT PERMITTED (e.g., tikki torches or campfires.)

- 8. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Please observe the state liquor laws. The <u>CHIEF</u> COOK will be responsible for the conduct of their team and guests.
- 9. **Absolutely no pets allowed**. No skateboards, tricycles, motorcycles, mopeds, golf carts, three wheelers or four-wheelers will be permitted in the cooking area.
- 10. Each team will be responsible for clean-up of their space.
- 11. Committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the committee and judges will be final.
- 12. Judging for **Bloody Mary** at 11:00 am.
- 13. Judging for Chef's Choice (Spam) at 12:30 pm.
- 14. Judging for **Margarita's** at 1:30 pm.
- 15. Judging for **Beans** will be at 2:30 pm.
- 16. Judging for **Chili** will be at 3:45 pm.
- 17. Contestants and Guest are welcome and encouraged to remain on the grounds after the competition Saturday night. There will be a free dance Saturday night. A deadline for cleaning the grounds and departure will be no later then noon on Sunday, October 22, 2023.
- 18. The Lloyd Saunders Memorial Foundation and Committee <u>WILL</u> <u>NOT</u> be liable for theft, damages or accidents.

### **AWARDS**

Plaques and Cash will be awarded for First thru Third place for Chili/Beans. Plaques and Cash will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Bloody Mary's, Margaritas, and Chef's Choice. There will be a free entry fee for next year cookoff for the winner of Showmanship/ Hospitality, no entry form is needed.
